

Reading

We know that reading with your child has unlimited benefits which don't stop at learning to read. Reading to your child gives them quality time, the opportunity to increase their language, rhyming and prediction skills as well as the chance to ask and answer questions. Reading takes children (and adults!) to other worlds and expands imagination so we encourage you to read with and to your child every day.

Tapestry

In Ducklings we use Tapestry which enables you to keep up with your child's learning at school and add any home learning they do. Each week we aim to let you know what's been going on in class and how you can support your child in extending and enhancing their learning.
