Dark sports trainers (predominantly black, navy / royal blue or grey)	<i>No hi-tops, converse-style trainers, flashing lights or canvas plimsolls. Please ensure trainers are sports style, not fashion style. No studs.</i> <i>Wellies can be worn to and from school in wet weather - please bring trainers to change into.</i>	
Accessories Hair should be tied back, with functional hair accessories only in school colours. Please do not wear jewellery. A wristwatch may be worn as long as children are able to remove it independently for sports.	<i>Please ensure ear piercings are done at the start of the summer holidays to allow them time to heal and be removed before coming to school.*</i> <i>No smart watches.</i>

***Surrey County Council Guidance:** Where total removal of earrings is not possible, retainers (flat studs that retain the piercing when earrings or studs are removed) are an acceptable substitution, provided these are flat and cannot cause damage if a blow or ball hits the side of the head. Parents should be aware that these studs are **not** designed to be worn for long periods and there are associated risks with using them if they are left in for several days. Where children are unable to remove earrings they should be taped over securely front and back by the child or parent (parents to provide tape) for sports. With taped earrings children will not be allowed to take part in contact sports or sports where contact from another pupil or piece of equipment may pose a risk (such as ball games, gymnastics). This does not apply to swimming, for which earrings must be removed in case they come off and get stuck in pool filters.
