Dear Parents,

Next week, Year Six will have the opportunity to visit the Priory pool for two swimming sessions, during the afternoons of Wednesday 6th July and Tuesday 12th July. During these sessions the children's self-rescue skills, use of different strokes and ability to swim 25m will be assessed by our swimming teachers.

The sessions will cost £5 altogether to cover the cost of pool hire and swimming teachers.

Please ensure that your child has their swimming costume (not bikinis or bermuda shorts please) and towel with them on both days. Swimming hats will be provided. After these sessions have been completed, those children who cannot achieve the 25m distance outlined by the National Curriculum will be offered further sessions before the end of term.

Please complete and return the attached form by the end of this week, including brief details of your child's medical needs for our swimming teachers, and whether they can already swim 25m, which will help us to group the children.
