Dear Year 5 Parents

RE: Year 5 Residential to High Ashurst, Tuesday 26th – Wednesday 27th June 2018

We are very much looking forward to the Year 5 residential - here are some final reminders to help you prepare.

Final Arrangements

You will need to arrange transport for your child to and from High Ashurst. Children will need to be dropped off between 09:15 and 09:30 on Tuesday 26th June and collected between 14:30 and 14:45 on Wednesday 27th June. Please arrange to share lifts where possible as parking at the centre is limited.

Kit List

- A packed lunch and drinks for the first day - **no fizzy drinks**
- A small selection of snacks in a sealed container - **no food containing nuts, no sweets.**
- Torch
- Pyjamas/nightwear
- A change of clothes for the following day
- Jumper, trousers, long sleeved t-shirt
- Old pair of trainers - **flip-flops, Crocs or open shoes are not suitable**
- Thick socks or slippers
- Towel and wash kit.
- Waterproof
- Sunhat and sunscreen

Please do NOT bring:

- Any electronic items (except a torch)
- Mobile phones
- Nice clothes which may get ruined
- Jewellery (ALL activities require jewellery to be removed)

Other information

- Clean bedding is provided and children will be expected to make up and strip their own beds. (bottom sheet, pillow, pillowcase, duvet, duvet cover)
- An evening meal will be provided on Tuesday, and breakfast and a packed lunch will also be provided by the centre on Wednesday. Fruit squash and hot chocolate are provided in the cabins.
- Outdoor shoes are not allowed inside the cabins - there is an area for outdoor shoes to be left.
- If children need any medication, this needs to be packed in a separate bag or container and handed to an adult, with written instructions on dose and administration, signed by a parent.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided in 2 log cabins on site. Each room has a private bathroom (sink, shower, toilet) and normally accommodates 4 children. Rooms will be allocated by staff. Adults from PCPS will stay in private rooms across the 2 cabins. The site is self-contained and secure.

Location

High Ashurst Outdoor Education Centre, Headley Lane, Mickleham, Dorking, RH5 6DQ.

SAT NAV users should input the postcode RH5 6DG for accurate directions to the entrance to High Ashurst's driveway. There is limited on-site parking for cars, minibuses and mini-coaches.
